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COMMUNITY CHEST 2024-25 NOW OPE

The Community Chest is a funding programme which has been running successfully for six years and has now reopened for 2024-25.

The programme continues to have a positive impact in communities across Northern Ireland ensuring tenants, service users, clients and small groups working within Radius have an opportunity to apply for funding from £250-£1000.

Last year 43 projects were funded totalling £33,296.58 and of those 21 projects were from Independent Living Schemes such as:

Mill Brae Fold Garden Chums who received £729.03 to purchase gardening equipment, flowers and plants to support tenants with their gardening project.

Sherbrook Close received £987.50 to facilitate Arts& Crafts classes supporting positive health, mindfulness, and creativity.

Elgin Court received £487.36 to purchase Bingo equipment and refreshments to run weekly Bingo afternoons.

Kingsway Fold received £550 to facilitate 6-week exercise classes bespoke to the tenants living in Kingsway.



Priority will be given to groups that haven't received funding in 2023-24 and we are keen to support groups that have never applied for funding before.

Radius Housing has become the first recipient of the Gold Award for Tenant **Engagement on the island of Ireland.**

This is the highest standard of Tenant Participation Accreditation awarded by Supporting Communities, and recognises Radius' continued commitment to engaging with their tenants and the recent audit and assessment process.

The accreditation framework identifies how and where Radius has applied good practice, supported by its own Tenant Engagement Strategy, in relation to the core standards and competencies required to attain a Supporting Communities'Tenant Participation Accreditation Award.

There are key steps that take place in the process before accreditation can be awarded which included providing evidence on how Radius and the Tenant Engagement Team engage with tenants, ensuring they have the opportunity to influence decisions, monitor performance and have a voice on the delivery of a wide range of services.
